

Artifacts - Blank Sources

Using $N_{\text{images}} > 1$ vs
 $N_{\text{images}} > 0$

The default is to use
 $N_{\text{images}} > 1$, to insure the
source is real.

However, there will be
cases when a person needs
to use $N_{\text{images}} > 0$.

An example is to search for
transient (one time) events.

BE CAREFUL !

There will be many more
artifacts (e.g., blank sources
from cosmic rays).

However, using $N > 1$ also
removes some real sources.

Blink between this VG and
the next to see the effect of
changing from $N_{\text{images}} > 1$
to $N_{\text{images}} > 0$.
