Addendum to Image Processing Information Packet

High Dispersion CalComp Plots

Effective immediately, all IUE high dispersion spectra for which the special authorization to plot the 2 $^{\circ}$ A/inch third CalComp file has been obtained (see addendum of 9 November 1978) will not have the second CalComp file (net ripple-corrected spectrum at 10 $^{\circ}$ A/inch) plotted. Since the second plot file is identical to the third except for a scale compression, it is redundant in those instances in which the third file is plotted, and hence its deletion will expedite the production procedure with essentially no loss of information.

Note that the first file (gross and smoothed background spectra at 10 %/inch) will continue to be plotted in all instances and that the second file will be plotted when the larger-scale third file is not being supplied.

These actions are being instituted in order to expedite the delivery of output products to the Guest Observer. At the direction of the GSFC IUE Project, this policy is being applied retroactively to all high dispersion spectra currently awaiting plotting as of 30 March 1979 as well as to all new images processed from that date forward.
