IUE PREPRINTS AND REPRINTS

All IUE observers should be reminded that both preprints and reprints of every paper using IUE data are to be sent to the IUE Project Scientist. These copies serve several important purposes:

- They allow the Observatory staff to remain current on IUE results, improving the advice and support we give to all observers and also to people who contemplate submitting new proposals.
- We can advise preprint authors about proper terminology for various observing and data processing procedures and can point out potential problems that we notice in the way data have been used.
- 3. The accumulated published papers from IUE are the ultimate basis for judging whether the project is worthwhile and whether NASA should continue to support it. The reprints you send us become our record of what has been accomplished.
- 4. In order to promote the exchange of information, henceforth each Newsletter will list the preprints we have received since the last Newsletter. Copies of these preprints ARE NOT available from the Observatory, but should be obtained directly from the authors. For practical reasons, the preprint lists will only include papers from NASA observers. However, if there is sufficient interest we may occasionally list UK and ESA publications that we are aware of.
